- Communicate with the Project Manager any notable irregularities with any vehicles/equipment in order to quickly diagnose and make repairs if needed.
- Works closely and communicates effectively with ground crew to complete assigned tasks in a timely manner.
- Follows directions diligently and immediately communicates with superiors when there are any issues or concerns with the directives received.
- Act as a team leader through leading by example, managing and communicating

directives given by superiors, and completing all project goals.
